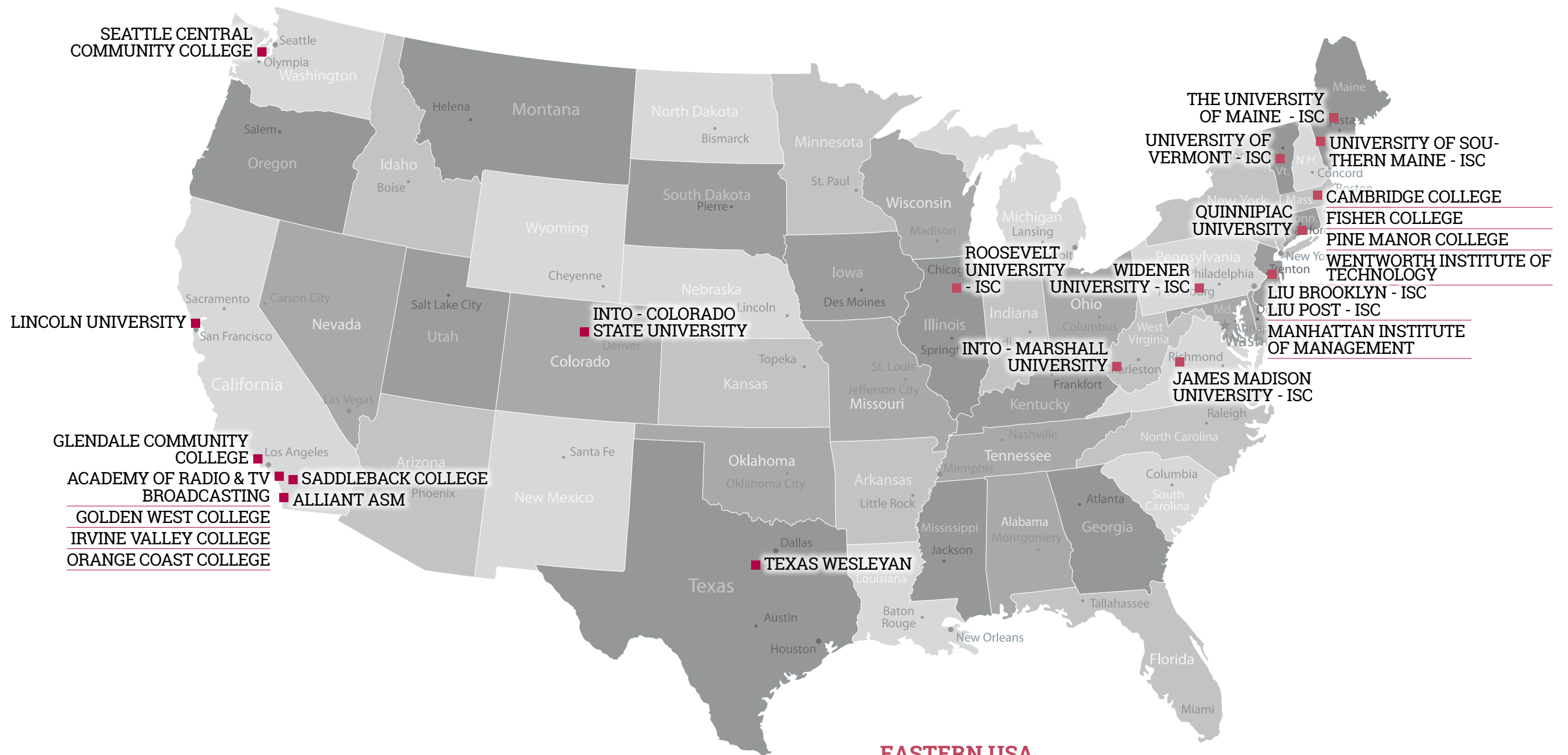

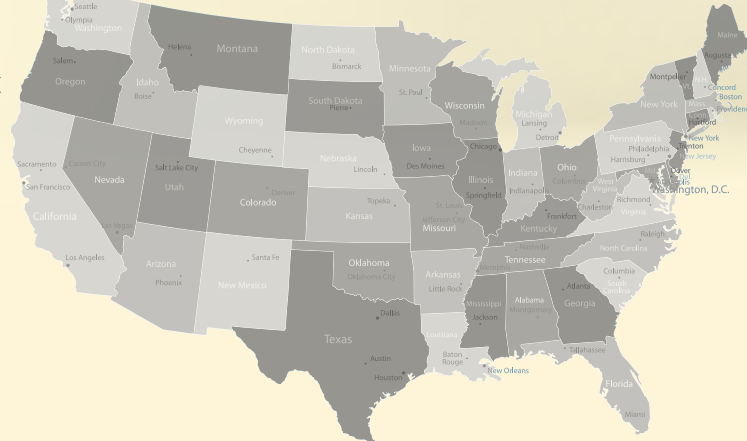

1 Take the online level test

Take the **GEOS Languages PLUS** On-line English Test at www.geos.net. It's a free test and should only take about 30 mins. In the unlikely event that the school is unable to create a group course due to it not having enough students at the same time/level, smaller group or private tutorials for a reduced number of lessons will be provided instead (20 lessons=12 privates; 30 lessons=18 privates).
