Volunteer Fields

- Students can select a volunteer field from six fields.
- Students can request volunteer day from the available volunteer time. Students generally
- volunteer 2 or 3 times a week.
- There is no minimum English level requirement to participate in this program.
- Program certificate will be provided after you finished the program.
- \$200 1-4 weeks, \$300 5-8 weeks, \$400 9-12 weeks, \$500 13-16 weeks
- Minimum 2 weeks notice to organize placement
